

CNAS SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Application Deadline: Monday April 10, 2006

Eligibility: any student in CNAS; see individual scholarships for other requirements

Bernarr J. Hall Scholarship (up to \$4,000 per award): for careers planned in California agriculture (min. GPA 3.2, California residents only).

The Dean's Fellowship (\$3,000 per award and \$300 for faculty mentor): for summer research in the College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences (min. GPA 2.0).

Dana King Scholarship (up to \$4,000 per award): for research in agriculture.

Herbert Kraft Scholarship Fund (up to \$4,000 per award): for students in the field of agriculture (California high school graduates only).

Homer and Daisy Chapman Endowed Scholarship in Citrus, Soil and Plant Nutrition Research (up to \$3,000 per award): for students in citrus research and soil and plant nutrition.

James and Margaret Lesley Annual Prize (up to \$1000 per award): for completed research in biological or agricultural science.

James and Adeline Wallace Prize (up \$2,500 per award): for completed research related to citrus or other plant pathology problems.

Janet M. Boyce Memorial Scholarship (up to \$3,000 per award): for women majoring in the sciences (undergraduate and graduate students).

Myron Winslow Distinguished Fellowship (up to \$6,400 per award): for students pursuing a career in agriculture or veterinary science.

Nathaniel T. Coleman Scholarship (up to \$1500 per award): for research in natural or agricultural science.

Tashiaki Hasegawa Scholarship (\$4,000 per award): for research in agriculture.
